- Develop, plan, and implement age-appropriate programs and activities that promote children's physical, cognitive, language, social, and emotional development, in alignment with the ELECT document and How Does Learning Happen?
- Lead activities such as storytelling, songs, games, creative expression, and outdoor play.
- Adapt program plans to meet the individual needs of children, including those with special needs.
- Assess children's development and progress, and provide feedback to parents/guardians.
- Work with parents, families, and other professionals to support children's learning and development.
- May supervise and mentor ECEAs, students, or volunteers.

Qualifications:

Early Childhood Educator (ECE):

- Diploma in Early Childhood Education from a recognized college.
- Registration with the College of Early Childhood Educators (RECE) in Ontario is required.
- Valid Standard First Aid and CPR Level C certification.
- Knowledge of the Child Care and Early Years Act (CCEYA) and other relevant legislation.

- Secondary School Diploma or equivalent.
